St Stephens Court provides nursing care and support for up to ten individuals with learning disabilities who may have complex Nursing needs.

The service comprises of ten en-suite rooms and a lounge area on the ground floor. There is also access to the in-house Inspire Centre Therapy Suite which includes Hydrotherapy, activity suite and sensory rooms.

The facility is designed to support individuals that may require intensive nursing care and therefore a qualified Nurse is on shift 24 hours per day supported by a qualified, caring staff team. Our staff team is comprised of general nurses, learning disability nurses, physiotherapy and support workers, providing the ideal skills resource to meet the holistic needs of service users with learning disabilities and complex health issues.

The staff team at St Stephens Court is vital to providing the foundation for a quality service, therefore the company have a strong commitment to individual development and professional growth of each team member.

All staff are supported through training programmes specifically tailored to the needs of the service users living at St Stephens Court. Training is delivered by our fully qualified 'in-house' trainer and when appropriate external training providers.

The service has access to a number of specialists including Physiotherapists, Behavioural and Occupational Therapists and other medical professionals.

Our staff team is experienced in supporting individuals with high nursing needs including: diabetes, oxygen therapy, dysphagia, aspirators, epilepsy, respiratory issues, alternative feeding regimes (PEG/PEJ), tissue viability and dementia.

Service Users friends, families and advocates are also involved to achieve the best possible outcomes for those living at the Service.

Our dedicated staff teams work closely with our service users and their families to build trusting relationships that optimise each individual persons functioning hence promoting physical, mental and emotional wellbeing.

St Stephens Court is proud to support individuals with complex health issues achieve the maximum possible independence and community presence. We combine our aim of the highest specialist nursing with the intrinsic right of Service Users to a varied, stimulating routine. Our Service users benefit from the proximity to Newcastle City Centre which gives easy access to community activities across the region.
